| GENERAL INFO: All sites are self-contained/primitive. Check-in starts at 11 a.m The Bath House/showers will be available during 9am – 12:00 pm daily. Reservations: creditcard/check/cash. | <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. No glass bottles or containers. Cans or plastic only.2. No Cruising. Driving is restricted to entering the park, leaving the park, 5-10 mph.3. No illegal carry of firearms or fireworks are allowed in the Park.4. No illegal substances are permitted in the Park.5. No one under 21 is permitted to consume alcohol beverages in the Park.6. Excessive use of alcohol will not be permitted.7. No disorderly conduct.8. No one is permitted to wander in wooded area beyond their campsite. The Park is not held responsible for injuries incurred due to camper's negligence.9. Pets are allowed at campsite only. They must be leashed at all times, crated, or within camper. Absolutely no pets allowed at Amphitheatre. The Park is not responsible for injuries caused by pet(s) due to camper's negligence.10. Small campfires permitted. No Fire rings available. No axes or saws are permitted; although clean firewood can be brought in for <i>small</i> contained campfires, <i>weather permitting</i>. Camper may make use of sticks and fallen trees on the ground.11. No damaging trees or wildlife. Anyone damaging or injuring animals, trees, or other wildlife while in the park will be fined, expelled and face possible prosecution. Please be respectful.12. No loud music past 11 pm. Be respectful to nearby campers.13. No more than 1 tent or 1 camper per site and 1 vehicle/parking per site. Maximum 5 people per site. Separate admission/and or parking fee purchases required when applicable.14. All structures have to be 10 feet from small contained campfires. This is state law.15. No children are to be unattended. Because parents and legal guardians are ultimately responsible for the actions of their children, please do not let your child wander around the park alone. You must be 18 years of age to camp at Park unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.16. No Alcohol, Food/Drink (coolers) brought in to camping area is allowed in Amphitheatre/Exhibit/Show area. Anything brought in must stay at your campsite. Violators will be asked to leave.17. No re-entry from 12am to 6am during Festival weekend. Gates will be closed during this time. | |

- 18. No ATV's/motor vehicles other than main transportation permitted.
- 19. Generators are permitted if under 70dB. We wish to respect other campers and keep the noise level down.
